- Soft Duffle Bags Only - No Suitcases, Space is Limited
- Layers - Prepare for All Weather, B.C. Weather is Ever-Changing Throughout the Year
- Consider Your Power Consumption - Limit the Number of Devices, No Hair Dryers.

Clothing

- Layers - Performance Fabrics, Fleece, Warm Sleeping Clothes, No Cotton
- Long Sleeve Shirts - For Layering & Sun Protection
- Pants/Pants - Light Weight, Comfortable, & Non-Restricting Performance Fabrics, No Jeans
- Shoes - Non-Marking, Non-Skid Deck Shoes, Shower Sandals for Marina Showers
- Socks - Extra Socks for Dry, Clean Feet
- Rain Gear - Water Proof Jacket & Pants
- Sailing/Deck Boots - Can be Useful in Rough Seas or Rain
- Gloves - Sailing Gloves with Grip, Mitts for Warmth
- Sun Protection - Hats, SPF
- More Layers - Warm Hat or Toque, Scarf or Buff
- Bathing Suit
- Sun Glasses - Polarized with Neck Strap

- Passport & Required Licenses - PCOC, ROC/VHF, Passport if Crossing U.S. Border Allowed
